Christmas Toy Donation Appeal 2014

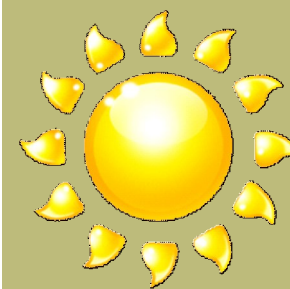
